On the 24th instant, by Thomas Ward, J.P., City Coroner, at the Destitute Asylum, Adelaide, on the body of Edward Simpson, who was found hanging by the neck from a tree dead on the Adelaide Racecourse on the previous day. Verdict—"Suicide by hanging himself."

On the 26th instant, by Thomas Ward, J.P., City Coroner, at the Sportsman's Hotel, Adelaide, on a fire which occurred on the shop premises of Gottschalk & Marsden, at Gouger-street, on the 23rd instant. Verdict—"No direct evidence to show how the fire originated."

On the 19th instant, by W. Warren, J.P., at Robe, on the body of Caroline O'Keefe, an aboriginal, who died in the police cell at above place, on the night of the 17th instant. Verdict—"Death by the visitation of God."

On the 19th instant, by F. T. Read, J.P., at Carrieton, on the body of Henry Hill, who died suddenly on the 17th instant. Verdict—"Death from debility, caused by intemperance and accelerated by an overdose of laudanum."

*Jane Pomeroy*, a married woman, a native of England, age 46 years, height 5ft. 3in., brown hair, brown eyes, scar left thumb; sentenced to one month imprisonment for larceny from Ah Lovey, at Moonta.

*John Murphy*, a laborer, a native of England, age 25 years, height 5ft. 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ in., dark hair, grey eyes, flower-pot, shrub, and anchor left wrist; sentenced to two months' hard labor for larceny from Coventry & Knipe, at Port Augusta.

*John Frank Baker*, a laborer, a native of England, age 26 years, height 5ft. 10in., light-brown hair, grey eyes, vaccine marks left arm; sentenced to two months' hard labor for larceny from James Warner and Thomas Norris, at Gladstone.

*Alfred Mansfield*, a laborer, a native of England, age 28 years, height 5ft. 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ in., fair hair, blue eyes; sentenced to six months' hard labor for assaulting and robbing Edward Hall, at Adelaide.
